

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

MAIN ROAD, KNOCKHOLT. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Main Road, Knockholt, on or after 15th May 2022 for up to 8 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Beechwood Cottage and Oak Cottage outside Holly Cottage.

The alternative route is via Main Road, Rushmore Hill, A21 Sevenoaks Road, Cudham Lane North, Cudham Lane South and vice versa.

MUSSENDEN LANE, HORTON KIRBY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of tree cutting to keep branches away from power lines, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Mussenden Lane, Horton Kirby, on or after 10th May 2022 for up to 1 day between 09.30hrs and 16.00hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Mussenden Farm House and The Barn.

The alternative route is via Mussenden Lane, Three Gates Road, Scratchers Lane, A20 Gorse Hill, Eglantine Lane and vice versa.

POUNDSBRIDGE LANE, PENSHURST. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of drainage works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Poundsbridge Lane, Penshurst, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Poundsbridge Lane and Bullingstone Lane.

The alternative route is via Poundsbridge Lane, B2176 Penshurst Road, Barden Road, Northfields and vice versa.

RECTORY LANE, BRASTED. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of drainage works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rectory Lane, Brasted, on or after 10th May 2022 for up to 16 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between A25 High Street and number 8.

The alternative route is via A25 High Street, Church Road, Coles Lane, Rectory Lane and vice versa.

RUSHMORE HILL, KNOCKHOLT (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rushmore Hill, Knockholt, on or after 29th May 2022 for up to 1 day between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside New Stables Farmhouse.

The alternative route is via Rushmore Hill, Halstead Lane, Knockholt Road, Shoreham Road, Station Road, Watercroft Road, London Road, Sevenoaks Road and vice versa.

SPRINGCROFT, HARTLEY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of carriageway repairs, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Springcroft, Hartley, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed. The road will be closed for the entire length.

There is no alternative route but access will be given as and when safe to do so.

SUNDRIDGE HILL, SUNDRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Sundridge Hill, Sundridge, on or after 10th May 2022 for up to 1 day between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed for the entire length.

The alternative route is via Sundridge Hill, Pilgrims Way, Brasted Hill, Brasted Lane, Main Road and vice versa.

WATERY LANE, KEMSING (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of drainage works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Watery Lane, Kemsing, on or after 11th May 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Heaverham Road and

The Old Byre.

The alternative route is via Watery Lane, Honey Pot Lane, Noahs Ark, St Ediths Road, High Street, Heaverham Road and vice versa.

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, THE DISTRICT OF SEVENOAKS) (20MPH, 30MPH, 40MPH, 50MPH SPEED LIMITS AND DERESTRICTED ROADS) AMENDMENT NO.32 ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as the Act) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following order.

The effect of the order would be to reduce the current speed limit from 30MPH to 20MPH on the following lengths of roads in Farningham, Sevenoaks:-

DARTFORD ROAD – From its junction with A20 London Road Roundabout to its junction with High Street.
HIGH STREET - From its junction with London Road to a point 7 metres west of its junction with Eynsford Road.
HILLSIDE - For its entire length.
LONDON ROAD - From its junction with A20 London Road to its junction with High Street.
SPAREPENNY LANE - From its junction with High Street for a distance of 110 metres in a southwesterly direction.

SWALE AREA

ALEXANDRA ROAD, SHEERNESS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Alexandra Road, Sheerness, on or after 12th May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from outside number 22 to outside number 32, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

It will also be necessary to temporarily suspend the following one-way Orders, to allow for diverted traffic.

- Alexandra Road, Sheerness - between the junctions with Clyde Street and Marine Parade.
- Clyde Street - between the junctions with Alexandra Street and Richmond Street.

The alternative route is via Clyde Street, Richmond Street, Marine Parade and vice versa.

BRENT HILL, FAVERSHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow clearance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Brent Hill, Faversham, on or after 11th May 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Flood Lane and Davington Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Brent Road, Church Road, Bramblehill Road, Reedland Crescent, Barnfield Road, Priory Row and Davington Hill.

FAVERSHAM FESTIVAL OF TRANSPORT (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow the Faversham Festival of Transport event to take place on the highway, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on certain roads in Faversham town centre.

This applies during the Faversham Festival of Transport Weekend being held on Saturday 14 and Sunday 15 May 2022.

Closures are from 07:00 hours through to 16:00 hours on both days, with the roads re-opened as soon as it is safe to do so.

The following roads will be closed to the extent indicated.

- Court Street – between the junctions with

Crescent Road and Market Place.

- East Street – between the junctions with Newton Road and Preston Street.
- Market Place – for its entire length.
- Market Street – for its entire length.
- Middle Row – for its entire length.
- Preston Street – between the junctions with East Street and Station Road/Forbes Road.
- Stone Street – between the junctions with Preston Street and Union Street.
- West Street – between the junctions with Market Place and North Lane.
- Leslie Smith Drive - for its entire length.
- Bank Street – for its entire length.
- Church Road – from the steps into Tesco car park to church entrance.
- Church Street – from Vicarage Street to church entrance.

MAPLE STREET, SHEERNESS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Maple Street, Sheerness, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 56A, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Maple Street, Vincent Gardens, High Street and vice versa.

MARINE PARADE, SHEERNESS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Marine Parade, Sheerness, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 9, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for traffic travelling eastbound is via Broadway, Trinity Road, Cavour Road, Invicta Road, High Street, Halfway Road, Minster Road, The Broadway, Marine Parade.

The alternative route for traffic travelling westbound is via Marine Parade, The Broadway, Minster Road, Halfway Road, High Street, Millenium Way, Trinity Road and Broadway.

SONORA WAY, SITTINGBOURNE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow frame and cover replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Sonora Way, Sittingbourne, on or after 19th May 2022 for up to 1 night between the hours of 19:00 and 05:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed at the junction with Jade Close, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Quinton Road, Sheppey Way, Bobbing Interchange, B2006 Staplehurst Road, Sonora Way and vice versa.

THROWLEY ROAD, THROWLEY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow ducting works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Throwley Road, Throwley, on or after 18th May 2022 for up to 8 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Throwley Road and Bagshill Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Throwley Road.

TONGE ROAD, TONGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow repair works to be carried out on a leaking water main, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Tonge Road, Sittingbourne, on or after 23rd May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Tonge Road and Homeview, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Tonge Road, Church Road and vice versa.

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, THE BOROUGH OF SWALE) (20MPH, 30MPH, 40MPH, 50MPH SPEED LIMITS AND DERESTRICTED ROADS) (AMENDMENT NO.20) ORDER 2022

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council hereby make an Order under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order would be to reduce the 40MPH speed limit and replace with a 30mph speed limit on the following length of road in Faversham, Swale:-

ASHFORD ROAD (A251) – From its junction with Canterbury Road (A2) to a point 90 metres south of its junction with Tettenhall Way.

The Order was made on 5 May 2022 and its provisions will come into effect on 6 May 2022.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

VARIOUS ROADS, FAVERSHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow gas main replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on various roads in Ospringe, on or after 16th May 2022, with estimated completion by 8th July 2022, or until the works have been completed.

The works will be carried out in phases, as detailed below.

Brogdale Road, Ospringe

Brogdale Road will be closed from 16th May 2022, with estimated completion by 10th June 2022.

The road will be closed from the junction with Plumford Road to north of the junction with Tettenhall Way, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site. The alternative route is via London Road, Ashford Road, Porters Lane or London Road, Water Lane, Painters Forstal Road and Eastling Road.

Porters Lane, Faversham

Porters Lane will be closed from 30th May 2022, with estimated completion by 24th June 2022.

The road will be closed from the junction with Brogdale Road to outside number 4, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site. The alternative route is via Porters Lane, Ashford Road, Old Badgins Road, Wilgate Green Road, Throwley Road, Stalisfield Road, Scooks Hill and Eastling Road.

Whitehill, Faversham

Whitehill will be closed from 30th May 2022, with estimated completion by 8th July 2022.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Brogdale Road and Eastling Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Eastling Road, Stalisfield Road, Throwley Road, Wilgate Green Road, Old Badgins Road, Ashford Road and London Road.

Stalisfield Road, Faversham

Stalisfield Road will be closed from 16th June 2022, with estimated completion by 8th July 2022.

The road will be closed from the junction with Eastling Road to outside number 1 Brook Meadow, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site. The alternative route is via Throwley Road, Wilgate Green Road, Old Badgins Road, Ashford Road, London Road and Porters Lane.

Eastling Road, Faversham

Eastling Road will be closed from 13th June 2022, with estimated completion by 8th July 2022.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Whitehill and Painters Forstal Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site. The alternative route is via Porters Lane, Ashford Road, Old Badgins Road, Wilgate Green Road, Throwley Road, Stalisfield Road, Scooks Hill and Eastling Road.
