GRAVESHAM AREA

BATTLE STREET, COBHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Southern Water works to replace a fire hydrant. Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Battle Street, Cobham, on or after 16th May 2022 for 3 days or until the works have been completed.

Scragged Oak Road, Stockbury - 30 mph speed limit will be imposed between the junctions with Cox Street and A249 Detling Hill.
