

Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

THANET AREA

A255 HIGH STREET & A255 THE BROADWAY, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow bridge examination works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A255 High Street and A255 The Broadway, Broadstairs, on or after 6th June 2022 for up to 1 night, between 22:00 hours and 05:30 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The roads will be closed for a distance approximately 20 metres either side of the rail bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A255 St Peters Road, A255 Broadstairs Road, Fairfield Road, Bromstone Road, A255 Ramsgate Road, A255 Queens Road, A255 High Street, and vice versa.

A28 CANTERBURY ROAD, SARRE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow cat's eye and lining replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of the A28 Canterbury Road, Sarre, on or after 23rd May 2022 for up to 3 nights, between 20:00 hours and 05:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions of the A299 St Nicholas Roundabout and A253 Ramsgate Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A253 Ramsgate Road, A253 Canterbury Road, A299 Monkton Roundabout, A299 Thanet Way, and vice versa.

A28 MARINE TERRACE, MARGATE (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022 THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994 SECTION 16A

For the safety of the public whilst an event is being held on the highway Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit the use of vehicles on:-

A28 Marine Terrace, Margate, between 09:30 hours and 14:30 hours from the 23rd May 2022, with completion by the 27th May 2022.

The alternative route for any westbound traffic is via A254 Belgrave Road, A254 Eaton Road, A255 Grosvenor Gardens, A255 High Street, A255 St Peters Road, B2052 College Road, B2052 Hartsdown Road, B2052 George V Avenue, and A28 Canterbury Road.

The alternative route for any eastbound traffic is via A28 Canterbury Road, B2052 George V Avenue, B2052 Hartsdown Road, Tivoli Road, Beatrice Road, B2052 College Road, A255 St Peters Road, A255 Ramsgate Road, A254 Queens Avenue, A254 Eaton Road, and A254 Belgrave Road.

CECILIA ROAD, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cecilia Road, Ramsgate, on or after 6th June 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 60, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Cecilia Road, College Road, Dumpton Lane, West Dumpton Lane, A255 Ramsgate Road, A255 Hereson Road, and vice versa.

KINGS AVENUE, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Kings Avenue, Broadstairs, on or after 6th June 2022 for up to 7 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between number 49 and the junction of Lanthorne Court, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Kings Avenue, Bishops Avenue, B2052 Stone Road, Knights Avenue, and vice versa.

KINGS AVENUE, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Kings Avenue, Broadstairs, on or after 8th June 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed at the side of Sandison Court, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Lanthorne Road, B2052 Stone Road, Bishops Avenue, and vice versa.

LINDEN AVENUE, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Linden Avenue, Broadstairs, on or after 6th June 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 13, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Linden Avenue, Crow Hill, and vice versa.

NASH COURT ROAD, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Nash Court Road, Margate, on or after 26th May 2022 for up to 1 night between

19:00 hours and 05:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 16, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Nash Court Road, A254 Ramsgate Road, Nash Lane, and vice versa.

PRINCES STREET, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow new water connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Princes Street, Margate, on or after 23rd May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed. The one-way Order will be suspended to allow access.

The road will be closed from its junction with Addington Street for a distance approximately 50 metres in a Westerly direction, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Princes Street, B2055 Cecil Street, Hawley Square, and Addington Street.

QUEENS ROAD AND BROCKENHURST ROAD, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Queens Road and Brockenhurst Road, Ramsgate, on or after 23rd May 2022 for up to 3 days, between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The roads will be closed between number 34 Queens Road and number 11 Brockenhurst Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Brockenhurst Road, Victoria Parade, Lyndhurst Road, Queens Road, and vice versa.

WEST CLIFF ROAD, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of West Cliff Road, Ramsgate, in 2 phases as detailed below:

Phase 1 - West Cliff Road will be closed at its junctions with Cannonbury Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Phase 2 - West Cliff Road will be closed at its junction with B2054 Grange Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic for both phases is via B2054 Grange Road, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Paragon, B2054 Royal Parade, Leopold Street, Queen Street, West Cliff Road, and vice versa.

VARIOUS ROADS, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Green Lane, High Street, Ranelagh Grove, & St Peters Road, Broadstairs, in 5 phases as detailed below:

Phase 1 - part of Green Lane will be closed from 6th June 2022 with estimated completion by 1st July 2022.

Phase 2 - part of Ranelagh Grove will be closed from 4th July 2022, with estimated completion by 22nd July 2022.

Phase 3 - part of High Street will be closed from 4th July 2022, with estimated completion by 5th August 2022.

Phase 4 - part of Green Lane will be closed from 18th July 2022, with estimated completion by 5th August 2022.

Phase 5 - part of St Peter's Road will be closed from 18th July 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd September 2022.

The roads closure lengths and diversion routes for each phase are detailed below:

Phase 1 - Green Lane will be closed between the junctions of Warren Drive and A255 Broadstairs Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via St Peters Road, A255 Broadstairs Road, and vice versa.

Phase 2 - Ranelagh Grove will be closed at its junction with High Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Vicarage Street, A255 Broadstairs Road, Green Lane, and vice versa.

Phase 3 - High Street will be closed between number 41 and the junction of Green Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via High Street, Vicarage Street, A255 Broadstairs Road, Green Lane, and vice versa.

Phase 4 - Green Lane will be closed between number 29 and the junction of St Peters Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via St Peters Road, A255 Broadstairs Road, and vice versa.

Phase 5 - St Peter's Road will be closed between number 65 and number 40, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via St Peters Road, A255 Broadstairs Road, Vicarage Street, High Street, and vice versa.
