

National Grid Electricity Transmission OVERHEAD LINE, LITTLEBROOK SUBSTATION, DARTFORD

Notice of Application for Section 37 Consent to replace a short section (removal of approximately 46m and installation of approximately 64m) of 400kV Overhead Line in the area of Dartford Borough Council.

Notice is hereby given that National Grid Electricity Transmission plc (National Grid) intends to make an application under Section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 for the consent of the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy for the replacement of a short section of existing 400kV (400,000 volts) overhead line to connect into the new substation at Littlebrook.

The overhead line replacement is required to connect the new substation to the existing overhead transmission lines, specifically comprising:

- The removal of approximately 46m of existing overhead line conductors between Tower ZBG13 and the existing National Grid Littlebrook substation.
- Installation of approximately 64m of overhead line conductors between Tower ZBG13 and new gantries located entirely within the new substation site off Rennie Drive, Dartford
