ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority, in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby proposes to make the following Order:-

The effect of the proposed named Order will introduce waiting restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) at any time on the following length of roads in Thanet:-

Roads in Margate in the District of Thanet

DANE ROAD – On the north western side from the junction with Approach Road for a distance of 10 metres in a north westerly direction.
