

## VARIOUS ROADS, MEDWAY (COMMUNITY EVENTS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (NO2) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that Medway Council intend to make an order the effect of which will be to impose the following temporary prohibitions or restrictions on traffic to facilitate the construction and removal of structures required for the holding of public community events, or because of the likelihood of danger to the public whilst the event is taking place –

**Traffic Management** - To facilitate the holding of the event mentioned in column (1) of the Table, on the dates and between the times set out in the corresponding columns (2) and (3), the traffic management provisions detailed in the schedule identified in the corresponding column (4) will apply. These provisions will be in force as indicated in the schedule below.

Pedestrian traffic will not be affected. Alternative routes for through traffic will be signed locally. Access to premises will be maintained where possible.

This order will come into force on Sunday, 3 July 2020 and will cease to have effect on Monday, 14 December 2020. The order will only be effective only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

### Schedule

**Schedule LCF22 – Road closures** - High Chatham from Union to Waterfront Way; Church Street – entire length; Clover Street at j/w High Street; Batchelor Street from Solomons Road to High Street; Military Road from Waterfront Way/Globe Lane to Railway Street

**Schedule CC22 - Traffic restrictions: Speed limit reduced to 10mph on the following roads**  
Boley Hill from St Margarets Street to High Street; Castle Hill from Castle Hill Court to Epaul Lane; Epaul Lane from Castle Hill to Boley Hill; The Precinct 30 metres from its southern junction with College Yard to College Yard; College Yard its entire length

**Schedule CC22/1: Road closures** - Castle Hill from Esplanade to Epaul Lane, to include Castle Hill Court; Epaul Lane from Castle Hill to Boley Hill – (to include relaxation of no entry and oneway operation); Boley Hill from High Street to St Margarets Street; College Yard at Boley Hill and The Precinct 30 metres from its southern junction with College Yard to College Yard

**Schedule CC22/2: Road closures** - As Schedule CC22/1 except College Yard plus College Yard at The Precinct – allowing resident access to rear of Cathedral College Yard at High Street; The Precinct 30 metres from its southern junction with College Yard to College Yard - Northgate from Cathedral car park to High Street (2130hrs to 2359hrs) High Street from Corporation Street bus lane to Blue Boar Lane (2130hrs to 2359hrs); Esplanade from High Street to roundabout 60m from Hathaway Court (2130hrs to 2359hrs)

### Traffic restrictions:

High Street southbound (Chatham bound) no vehicle is permitted to right turn into Esplanade (2130hrs to 2359hrs) High Street northbound (Strood bound) no vehicle is permitted to left turn into Esplanade (2130hrs to 2359hrs) Suspension of on street parking: Esplanade on street parking from High Street to Bakers Walk (both sides) excluding private RBT (Rochester Bridge Trust) bays Castle Hill – entire length

**Schedule MM22: Road closures** - Wood Street from Wood Street roundabout to Prince Arthur Road; Brompton Road from Prince Arthur Road to Mill Road; Prince Arthur Road from Brompton Road to Mill Road; Mill Road - entire length one way only (northbound working High Street to Medway Street); Mansion Row at Wood Street no vehicle is permitted to right turn; Admiralty Terrace at Wood Street no vehicle is permitted to left turn; Lennox Row at Wood Street no vehicle is permitted to left turn Suspension of on street parking Brompton Road from its junctions with Mill Road to Prince Arthur Road (both sides)

**Schedule MP22/1: Road closures** - Castle Hill from Esplanade to Epaul Lane, to include Castle Hill Court

**Street parking:** Esplanade on street parking from High Street to Bakers Walk – to include relaxation of no entry and oneway operation

Boley Hill from High Street to St Margarets Street College Yard at Boley Hill

**Schedule MP22/2: Road closures** - High Street Rochester from Guildhall to Star Hill; Almon Place at High Street; Bishops Walk at High Street; Eastgate Court at High Street; Eastgate Terrace at High Street; Crow Lane from High Street to Vines Lane; Blue Boar Lane from car park entrance to High Street; La Providence at High Street; Northgate from Cathedral car park to High Street; Cathedral Car Park at High Street

College Yard at High Street; Almon Place suspend southbound only working and allow two-way traffic flow

**Schedule SW1: Intermittent road closures;** Castle Hill from Esplanade to Epaul Lane, to include Castle Hill Court; Epaul Lane from Castle Hill to Boley Hill - to include relaxation of no entry and oneway operation; Boley Hill from High Street to St Margarets Street The roads above will be closed intermittently throughout these dates to allow for vehicle/plant ingress and/ or egress to the Castle Gardens and Castle Moat area

**Schedule RE22: Road Closures and traffic restrictions** - High Street Rochester from Corporation Street bus lane to Bishops Walk Eastgate Court at High Street - Eastgate Terrace at High Street - Crow Lane from - High Street to Vines Lane - Blue Boar Lane from car park entrance to High Street - La Providence at High Street - Cathedral Car Park at High Street - Northgate from Cathedral car park to High Street - Boley Hill from St Margarets Street to High Street - College Yard at Boley Hill - College Yard at The Precinct - Castle Hill from Esplanade to Epaul Lane, to include Castle Hill Court - Epaul Lane from Castle Hill to Boley Hill – to include relaxation of no entry and oneway operation - Corporation Street southbound (Chatham Bound) no vehicle is permitted to right hand turn into Northgate

### Suspension of on street parking:

Crow Lane from High Street to it junction with Vines Lane (both sides)

Northgate from Corporation Street to it junction with High Street

Blue Boar Lane from Corporation Street to it junction with High Street

### Visitors Information Centre coach set down/pick up, Corporation Street Rochester

Suspension of existing maximum waiting period set down / pick up 1 hour only to be replaced with maximum waiting period –set down / 15 minutes only – with exemption for event vehicles only

**Schedule FWN22/1: Suspension of on-street parking** Brompton Road from its junctions with Mill Road to Prince Arthur Road (both sides) Marlborough Road (5 bays opposite Stafford Street)

**Schedule FWN22/2: Road closures** - Marlborough Road from Brompton Road to York Avenue – entire length - Lock Street from Marlborough Road to Canterbury Street - Paget Street from Marlborough Road to Canterbury Street - Stafford Street from Marlborough Road to Canterbury Street Britton Street - its entire length - Saxton Street – its entire length - College Avenue at Stafford Street to York Avenue - Brompton Road from Prince Arthur Road to High Street -High Street from Skinner Street to Britton Street - Jeffery Street from High Street to Skinner Street - Fox Street at Jeffery Street - Arden Street at Jeffery Street - Mill Road - entire length one way only

The order will be effective only when the appropriate signs are being displayed.
