

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

COOMBE VALLEY ROAD, DOVER. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of bridge repair works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Coombe Valley Road, Dover, on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 4 nights, between 22:00 hours and 05:00 hours or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Edgar Road and Magdala Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Coombe Valley Road, A256 London Road/Crabble Hill, Crabble Road, Crabble Avenue, Hillside Road, Bunkers Hill Road, St Radigunds Road and Barwick Road.

MONGEHAM ROAD, GREAT MONGEHAM. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of new utility connection works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Mongeham Road, Great Mongeham, on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 12 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Ellens Road and Mongeham Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Mongeham Road, Sutton Road, Beacon Hill, Willow Road, Northbourne Road and vice versa.

THE DROVEWAY, ST MARGARETS BAY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of new utility connection works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of The Drove Way, St Margarets Bay, on or after 28th June 2022 for up to 7 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between number 40 and Convent Close, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There will be no alternative route but access will be maintained when it is safe to do so.

UPPER ROAD, GUSTON & ST MARGARETS AT CLIFFE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of new fibre connection works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Upper Road, Guston and St Margarets At Cliffe, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 3 days, between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Roman Way and the Maritime and Coastguard Agency, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Reach Road, High Street, Station Road, A258 Deal Road, Upper Road and vice versa.

FOLKESTONE & HYTHE AREA

B2063 WEST ROAD, FOLKESTONE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of the installation of surface water and foul water drainage, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of B2063 West Road, Folkestone, on or after 29th June 2022 for up to 22 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Sandy Lane and Pond Hill Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via B2063 North Road/Military Road, A259 Sandgate High Street/Sandgate Esplanade/Seabrook Road, B2063 Hospital Hill/West Road and vice versa.

NAILDOWN ROAD, HYTHE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of new utility connection works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Naildown Road, Hythe, on or after 30th June 2022 for up to 7 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the vicinity of number 24, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Naildown Road, Horn Street, Spring Lane, Highridge and vice versa.

SEAVIEW BRIDGE FOOTPATH, HYTHE. (PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow the placement of hoarding, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit pedestrian traffic on Seaview Bridge footpath on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 18 months or until the works have been completed.

Seaview Bridge footpath will be closed south of Seaview Bridge to Princes Parade.

The alternative route is via College Bridge.

TANNERS HILL, HYTHE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of works to coredrill into chamber and lay duct

in the footway, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Tanners Hill, Hythe, on or after 13th July 2022 for up to 3 days, between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours or until the works have been completed. The one-way order will be suspended to allow access.

The road will be closed in the vicinity of number 3, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Tanners Hill, North Road, Station Road and vice versa.

WALNER LANE, NEW ROMNEY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of works to lay duct in the carriageway and verge, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Walner Lane, New Romney, on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 5 days, between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Rolfe Lane and Walnercroft, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Rolfe Lane, Craythorne Lane, Fairfield Road and vice versa.

GRAVESHAM AREA

A227 WROTHAM ROAD, GRAVESSEND. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Southern Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A227 Wrotham Road, Gravesend, on or after 30th June 2022 for up to 1 night between 22.30hrs and 03.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 223.

The alternative route is via A227 Wrotham Road, Coldharbour Road, Earl Road, Perry Street, Pelham Road South, B261 Old Road West and vice versa.

SEYMOUR ROAD, NORTHFLEET. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Southern Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Seymour Road, Northfleet, on or after 28th June 2022 for up to 4 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 44.

The alternative route is via Seymour Road, Nelson Road, Bedford Road and vice versa.

ST GEORGES CRESCENT, GRAVESSEND. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Southern Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of St Georges Crescent, Gravesend, on or after 30th May 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 26.

The alternative route is via St Georges Crescent, St Davids Crescent, St Hildas Way and vice versa.

MAIDSTONE AREA

A20 ASHFORD ROAD, HOLLINGBOURNE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of A20 Ashford Road, Hollingbourne, on or after 26th June 2022, with estimated completion by 8th July 2022, or until the works have been completed.

A20 Ashford Road will be closed from the junction with Old Mill Lane to outside Oakfield House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The works will be carried out in phases, with only one direction of traffic being affected at a time.

Phase 1

A20 Ashford Road will be closed (Westbound only) from outside Oakfield House to the junction with Old Mill Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic (excluding over height) is via A20 Ashford Road, A20 Maidstone Road, A252 Charing Hill, A252 Canterbury Road, A251 Faversham Road, A251 Ashford Road, A2 London Road, A249 Maidstone Road, A249 Sittingbourne Road, A249 Detling Hill, A249 Bearsted Road, A249 Andrew Broughton Way and A20 Ashford Road.

The alternative route for over height vehicles is via A20 Ashford Road, A20 Maidstone Road, A252 Charing Hill, A252 Canterbury Road, A251 Faversham Road, A251 Ashford Road, A2 London Road, A249 Maidstone Road, A249 Sittingbourne Road, A249 Detling Hill, Bearsted Road, New Cut Road and A20 Ashford Road.

Additional Traffic management will be in place during the westbound closure on A20 Ashford Road, as detailed below.

B2163 Penfold Hill will be closed near the junction with A20 Ashford Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via B2163 Penfold Hill, B2163 Lower Street, B2163 Upper Street, B2163 Leeds Road,

A274 Sutton Road, Willington Street and A20 Ashford Road.

Old Mill Road will be closed at the junction with A20 Ashford Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Forge Lane, Caring Lane and A20 Ashford Road.

A no right turn restriction will be temporarily imposed on Eyhorne Street. Restricting vehicles exiting Eyhorne Street from turning right onto the A20 Ashford Road.

The alternative route for this restriction will be via the official diversion route.

Vehicles wishing to join the A20 from M20 J8 will be diverted London bound on the M20 to J7.

Phase 2

A20 Ashford Road will be closed (Eastbound only) from the junction with M20 J8 roundabout to outside Oakfield House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic (excluding over height vehicles) is via A20 Ashford Road, A249 Andrew Broughton Way, A249 Sittingbourne Road, A249 Bearsted Road, A249 Detling Hill, A249 Sittingbourne Road, A249 Maidstone Road, A2 London Road, A251 Ashford Road, A251 Faversham Road, A252 Canterbury Road, A252 Charing Hill, A20 Maidstone Road and A20 Ashford Road.

The alternative route for over height vehicles is via A20 Ashford Road, New Cut Road, Bearsted Road, A249 Detling Hill, A249 Sittingbourne Road, A249 Maidstone Road, A2 London Road, A251 Ashford Road, A251 Faversham Road, A252 Canterbury Road, A252 Charing Hill, A20 Maidstone Road and A20 Ashford Road.

Additional Traffic management will be in place during the eastbound closure on A20 Ashford Road, as detailed below.

Eyhorne Street to be closed at the junction with A20 Ashford Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for traffic travelling west on A20 Ashford Road is via Eyhorne Street, Hollingbourne Hill, Swanton Street, Bredgar Road, Tunstall Road, Woodstock Road, Bell Road, Crown Quay Lane, A2 London Road, A249 Maidstone Road, A249 Sittingbourne Road, A249 Detling Hill, A249 Bearsted Road, A249 Sittingbourne Road, A249 Andrew Broughton Way and A20 Ashford Road.

The alternative route for traffic travelling east on A20 Ashford Road is via Eyhorne Street, Hollingbourne Hill, Swanton Street, Bredgar Road, Tunstall Road, Woodstock Road, Bell Road, Crown Quay Lane and then join official diversion route.

The no right turn restriction on B2163 Penfold Hill will be temporarily suspended to allow vehicles to join onto A20 Ashford Road.

A249 DETLING HILL, SITTINGBOURNE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow high speed road maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made Order prohibiting through traffic travelling southbound on A249 Detling Hill, Detling, on or after 24th June 2022 for up to 1 night between the hours of 20:00 and 05:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed southbound between the junctions with Scragged Oak Road and Pilgrims Way, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for motorway traffic is via Stockbury Roundabout, M2 J5 to J4 on-slip, M2, M2 J3 from J4 off-slip, Bluebell Hill Slip Link Bridge, Bluebell Hill Slip South on, A229 Blue Bell Hill, Cobtree Roundabout, M20 J6 to J7 on-slip, M20, M20 J7 from J6 off-slip and Newnham Court Roundabout.

The alternative route for non-motorway traffic is via Stockbury Roundabout, A249 Maidstone Road, Key Street northbound off-slip, A2 Keycol Hill, Boyce Hill, High Street, London Road, Hartlip Hill, London Road, Moor Street, High Street, London Road, Bowaters Roundabout, Watling Street, Will Adams Roundabout, Watling Street, Rainham Road, Chatham Hill, Luton Arches Roundabout, New Road, A230 Maidstone Road, Horsted Way, Horsted Roundabout, A229 Maidstone Road, Tiger Moth Roundabout, Blue Bell Hill, Chatham Road, Cobtree Roundabout, Running Horse Roundabout, Sandling Lane, Penenden Heath Road, Sittingbourne Road, Bearsted Road, Newnham Court Roundabout and Newnham Court Roundabout.

A249 WAT TYLER WAY & MOTE ROAD, MAIDSTONE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on A249 Wat Tyler Way and Mote Road, Maidstone, on or after 6th July 2022 for up to 9 night between the hours of 20:00 and 05:00, or until the works have been completed.

The roads will be closed between the junctions with A229 Upper Stone Street and A20 Ashford Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic (excluding over height) travelling eastbound is via A229 Upper Stone Street, A229 Loose Road, A274 Sutton Road, Willington Street, A20 Ashford Road and vice versa.

The alternative route for any through traffic (excluding over height) travelling westbound is via A20 Ashford Road, Willington Street, A274 Sutton Road, A229 Loose Road, Sheals Crescent, Hayle Road, College Road, Mill Street, Palace Avenue, Lower Stone Street.

The alternative route for over height vehicles travelling eastbound is via A229 Upper Stone Street, Loose Road, A274 Sutton Road, Willington Street, A20 Ashford Road, New Cut Road, A249 Bearsted Road, Sittingbourne Road, Andrew Broughton Way, A20 Ashford Road and vice versa.

The alternative route for over height vehicles travelling westbound is via A249 Andrew Broughton Way, Sittingbourne Road, Bearsted Road, New Cut Road, A20 Ashford Road, Willington Street, A274 Sutton Road, A229 Loose Road, Sheals Crescent, Hayle Road, College Road, Mill Street, Palace Avenue, Lower Stone Street.

B2010 LOWER ROAD, EAST FARLEIGH. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow repair works to be carried out to damaged chamber, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of B2010 Lower Road, East Farleigh, on or after 29th June 2022 for up to 3 days between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of East Farleigh House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via B2010 Lower Road, Ewell Lane, B2163 Heath Road, Dean Street and vice versa.

B2162 HAMPSTEAD LANE, NETTLESTEAD. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow works to be carried out to install apparatus, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Hampstead Lane, Nettlestead, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 4 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of The Orchard, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The 7.5 tonne weight restriction on Gravelly Ways, Laddingford will be temporarily suspended, to allow for diverted traffic.

The alternative route is via Hampstead Lane, Maidstone Road, Maidstone Road Roundabout, Hale Street By Pass, Hale Street, Branbridges Road, Branbridges Ind Est Roundabout, Beltring Road, Gravelly Ways, Lees Road and vice versa.

BLUE REEF FESTIVAL 2022. (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF LEFT AND RIGHT HAND TURN RESTRICTIONS) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow the Blue Reef Festival event to be held, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily suspend left and right hand turns on parts of Loddington Lane & B2163 Heath Road, Boughton Monchelsea, on or after 15th July 2022, with estimated completion by 17th July 2022, or until the works have been completed.

Loddington Lane will not be closed during this period. However, it will be necessary to temporarily suspend the left and right hand turns on the B2163 Heath Road, restricting traffic from turning into Loddington Lane.

The suspensions are in place to ensure a northbound one-way system is formed on Loddington Lane.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Butt Green Lane, A229 Linton Hill, B2163 Heath Road and vice versa.

BURBERRY LANE, LEEDS. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow water main connection works to be carried, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Burberry Lane, Leeds, on or after 13th July 2022 for up to 10 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed at the junction with B2163 Upper Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Burberry Lane, B2163 Lower Street, Upper Street and vice versa.

FISHER STREET, MAIDSTONE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow underground structure works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order
