

Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

prohibiting through traffic on part of Fisher Street, Maidstone, on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 5 days between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Perryfield Street and Thornhill Place, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for vehicles wishing to access Arundel Street is via Peel Street, Canning Street, Chillington Street and Arundel Street.

The alternative route for vehicles wishing to access Perryfield Street is via Peel Street, Canning Street, Chillington Street, Arundel Street, Perry Street, Albert Street and Perryfield Street.

The alternative route for vehicles wishing to access Fisher Street is via Arundel Street, Chillington Street, Canning Street, John Street and Thornhill Place.

GREEN LANE, MARDEN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Green Lane, Marden, on or after 9th July 2022 for up to 2 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from the vicinity of Spritz Bridge for 300 metres, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Green Lane, Underlyn Lane, B2079 Maidstone Road, High Street, Church Green, West End, Goudhurst Road, Sheephurst Lane, Claygate, B2162 Collier Street and vice versa.

HEATH ROAD, LANGLEY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow joint bay and electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Heath Road, Langley, on or after 12th July 2022 for up to 7 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 20, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via B2163 Leeds Road, A274 Sutton Road, Horseshoes Lane, Heath Road and vice versa.

OLD ASHFORD ROAD, LENHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow foul water drainage works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Old Ashford Road, Lenham, on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 52 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of the new development (Abbey Homes), to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Old Ashford Road, Faversham Road, A20 Ashford Road and vice versa.

PLAIN ROAD, MARDEN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Plain Road, Marden, on or after 17th July 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of Beech Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Plain Road, Albion Road, Howland Road, High Street, Church Green, West End, Goudhurst Road and vice versa.

WEST WALK, MAIDSTONE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow footway reconstruction works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of West Walk, Maidstone, on or after 4th July 2022 for up to 35 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Cherry Orchard Way and Queens Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Cherry Orchard Way, Greenway, Queens Road and vice versa.

VARIOUS ROADS, OTHAM AND DOWNSWOOD (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow development works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on various roads in Otham and Downswood on or after 27th June 2022, with estimated completion by 7th April 2023, or until the works have been completed.

The works will be carried out in phases, as detailed below.

Phase 1

Deeringwood Drive, Downswood will be closed from 27th June 2022, between the hours 08:45 and 15:30, with estimated completion by 1st July 2022.

The road will be closed at the junction with Church Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Church Road, Gore Court Road, Sutton Road, Willington Street and Deringwood Drive.

Phase 2

Church Road, Otham (North) will be closed from 4th July 2022, with estimated completion by 19th August 2022.

The road will be closed from outside Rectory Cottage to outside number 18, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Church Road, Gore Court Road, Sutton Road, Willington Street and Deringwood Drive.

Phase 3

Church Road, Otham (South) will be closed from 22nd August 2022, with estimated completion by 21st October 2022.

The road will be closed from outside number 18 to outside Rectory Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Church Road, Gore Court Road, Sutton Road, Willington Street and Deringwood Drive.

Phase 4

Willington Street, Otham will be closed from 6th March 2023, between the hours of 20:00 and 05:00, with estimated completion by 24th March 2023.

The road will be closed from at the junction with Deeringwood Drive, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A20 Ashford Road, New Cut Road, A249 Bearsted Road, Sittingbourne Road, Andrew Broughton Way, Ashford Road, Wat Tyler Way, Mote Road, A229 Upper Stone Street, Loose Road, A274 Sutton Road.

Phase 5

Spot Lane, Otham will be closed from 27th March 2023, with estimated completion by Friday 7th April 2023.

The road will be closed from at the junction with A20 Ashford Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Spot Lane, Mallards Way, Deringwood Drive, Willington Street and A20 Ashford Road.

This phase of works will cause no disturbance to the A20 Ashford Road

SEVENOAKS AREA

B2027 CLINTON LANE, BOUGH BEECH. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Network Rail works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2027 Clinton Lane, Bough Beech, on or after 23.00hrs on 25th June 2022, with estimated completion by 02.00hrs on 27th June 2022 or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed either side of the railway.

The alternative route is via B2027 Clinton Lane/Bough Beech Road, B269 Pootings Road/Spout Lane, B2026 Main Road/Station Road/Mont St Aignan Way/High Street, Hever Road, B2027 Chequers Hill and vice versa.

BUTTON STREET, SWANLEY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Button Street, Swanley, on or after 28th June 2022 for up to 1 day between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed for the entire length.

The alternative route is via Button Street, A20 London Road, A225 Dartford Road, Main Road, Ship Lane, Wood Street and vice versa.

CASTLE HILL, HARTLEY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Castle Hill, Hartley, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Endsleigh.

The alternative route is via Castle Hill, Fawkham Road, B260 Main Road, Hartley Road, Ash Road and vice versa.

DALTONS ROAD, CHELSFIELD. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Thames Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Daltons Road, Chelsfield, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 4 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Willow Cottage and Skeet Hill Cottages.

The alternative route is via Daltons Road, Skeet Hill Lane, Gorse Road, Skibbs Lane, East Hall Road, Waldens Road, B258 Crockenhill Road/Cray Road, Tylers Green Road and vice versa.

IDE HILL ROAD, BOUGH BEECH. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Ide Hill Road, Bough Beech, on or after 29th June 2022 for up to 1 day between 08.00hrs and 18.00hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside The Rustles.

The alternative route is via Ide Hill Road, Coopers Corner, B2042 Green Lane/Ide Hill Road, B2027 Bough Beech Road/Clinton Lane and vice versa.

LARKS FIELD, HARTLEY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of carriageway repairs, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Larks Field, Hartley, on or after 30th June 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Gresham Avenue and Larkwell Lane.

The alternative route is via Gresham Avenue, Church Road, Ash Road, Larks Field and vice versa.

NIGHTINGALE LANE, IDE HILL. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Nightingale Lane, Ide Hill, on or after 30th June 2022 for up to 1 day between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Conifers and Assets.

The alternative route is via Nightingale Lane, Gracious Lane, B2042 Wheatsheaf Hill and vice versa.

NORTHVIEW, SWANLEY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of carriageway repairs, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Northview, Swanley, on or after 1st July 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between The Spinney and Sycamore Drive.

The alternative route is via Sycamore Drive, B2173 Bartholomew Way/Maidstone Road, Hilda May Avenue, Northview and vice versa.

OLD FARM GARDENS, SWANLEY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of gully repairs, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Old Farm Gardens, Swanley, on or after 29th June 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 45.

There is no alternative route but access will be given as and when safe to do so.

RYE LANE, OTFORD. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rye Lane, Otford, on or after 29th June 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Homestead Farm.

The alternative route is via Rye Lane, Station Road, A224 London Road, London Road, Pilgrims Way West and vice versa.

TONBRIDGE ROAD, SEVENOAKS. (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow application of footway preservation treatment works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily impose a 20mph speed limit on part of A225 Tonbridge Road, Sevenoaks, between Solefields Road and The White Hart Public House.

The restriction is planned between 09.30hrs and 15.00hrs from 30th June 2022, with estimated completion by 30th November 2022.

WINDMILL ROAD, SEVENOAKS WEALD. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit

through traffic on part of Windmill Road, Sevenoaks Weald, on or after 28th June 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Apple Orchard.

The alternative route is via Windmill Road, Church Road, Glebe Road and vice versa.

SWALE AREA

A250 QUEENBOROUGH ROAD, MINSTER-ON-SEA (TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow road widening, ducting and resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to impose a temporary mandatory 30 mph speed limit on A250 Queenborough Road, Minster-on-sea on or after 28th June 2022, with estimated completion by 1st August 2022, or until the works have been completed.

The temporary mandatory 30 mph speed limit will be imposed 30 metres either side of the junction with Belgrave Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

CROCKHAM LANE, HERNHILL (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Crockham Lane, Hernhill, on or after 12th July 2022 for up to 7 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside the land adjacent to Crockham Farm to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Crockham Lane, Church Hill, Staplestreet Road, Dawes Road, Thread Lane, Crockham Road and vice versa.

HIGH STREET, SITTINGBOURNE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of High Street, Sittingbourne, on or after 13th July 2022 for up to 1 night between the hours of 19:00 and 05:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Park Road and Central Avenue, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Park Road, Albany Road, Avenue Of Remembrance, Central Avenue and High Street.

HOPES HILL, DODDINGTON (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow frame and cover renewal works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Hopes Hill, Doddington, on or after 12th July 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed at the junction with Seed Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Seed Road, The Street, Doddington Lane, Hopes Hill and vice versa.

LONDON BOUND LAYBY A299 THANET WAY, GRAVENEY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow a layby closure to be in place to support Operation Brock, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic the London bound Layby on A299 Thanet Way, Graveney, on 25th June 2022 for up to 12 months, or until the works have been completed.

The London bound layby on A299 Thanet Way, Graveney will be closed 700 metres north of the junction with Brenley Corner, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

PERRY WOOD, SELLING (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow water main works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Perry Wood, Selling, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 4 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed south of the junction with Beeches Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Grove Road, Shepherds Hill, Perry Wood and vice versa.

PLOUGH ROAD, MINSTER-ON-SEA (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022
