

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Plough Road, Minster-on-sea, on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 3 days between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with the entrance to Golden Leas Holiday Park and the entrance to Plough Leisure Park, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Plough Road, Chequers Road, Eastchurch Road, Lower Road, High Street, Warden Road and vice versa.

SCOCLES ROAD, MINSTER-ON-SEA (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow development works to be carried out under a Section 278 agreement, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Scocles Road, Minster-on-sea, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 10 weeks or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Elm Lane and Drake Avenue, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Scocles Road, Thistle Hill Way, Plover Road, Barton Hill Drive, Minster Road, High Street, Back Lane and vice versa.

SHEPPEY WAY, IWADE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow rail bridge maintenance works to be carried out Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Sheppey Way, Iwade, on or after 16th July 2022 for up to 1 day between the 02:00 and 23:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of Kingsferry rail bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Sheppey Way, Lower Road, Brielle Way, The Sheppey Crossing, A249 Sheppey Way, The Sheppey Crossing, Iwade Bypass, Grovehurst Slip southbound off, Grovehurst Road, Grovehurst Slip northbound on, A249 Iwade Bypass, Kingsferry Roundabout, Sheppey Way, Kingsferry Bridge and vice versa.

TANNERS STREET, FAVERSHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow drainage survey works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Tanners Street, Faversham, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Napleton Road and West Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via B2040 South Road, Lower Road and Stonebridge Way.

SWALE AND TONBRIDGE & MALLING AREAS

VARIOUS ROADS, TONBRIDGE & MALLING & SWALE (TEMPORARY 20 MPH SPEED RESTRICTIONS) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow works to be carried out as part of a footway protection treatment scheme Kent County Council has made an Order to impose temporary mandatory 20 mph speed restrictions on various roads in Tonbridge & Malling and Swale from 27th June 2022, with estimated completion by 30th November 2022.

The temporary mandatory 20 mph speed restrictions will be imposed on the following roads between the hours of 09:30 and 15:00 only.

- Canterbury Road, Faversham - between the junctions with Preston Avenue and Love Lane, to the extent indicated clearly by signs on site.
- London Road, Hildenborough - from outside Teal Cafe to the junction with Noble Tree Road, to the extent indicated clearly by signs on site.
- Red Hill, Watlingtonbury - from the junction with Malling Road to outside number 20, to the extent indicated clearly by signs on site.

TONBRIDGE & MALLING AREA

A227 GRAVESEND ROAD, WROTHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow fibre connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of A227 Gravesend Road, Wrotham, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 1 night between the hours of 21:00 and 05:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with A20 London Road and Vigo Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A20 London Road, Gorse Hill, Main Road, A225 Dartford Road, Main Road, Parsonage Lane, Darent Hill, B260 Watchgate, Green Street, Main Road, Longfield Road, A227 Wrotham Road, South Street, Wrotham Road, Whitepost Lane, Gravesend Road and vice versa.

ASHES LANE, HADLOW (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow pole maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Ashes Lane, Hadlow on or after 14th July 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Higham Lane and High House Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Higham Lane, Cuckoo Lane, A26 Hadlow Road East, Tonbridge Road, Ashes Lane and vice versa.

BANK STREET, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow works to be carried out to install a new gas service, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Bank Street, Tonbridge, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 8 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed at the rear of number 164 High Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The one-way Order on Bank Street will be temporarily suspended, between the junctions with Castle Street and B2260 High Street, to allow for access.

The alternative route is via B2260 High Street, Castle Street and Bank Street.

HIGH HOUSE LANE, HADLOW (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow gas service works and crossover works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of High House Lane, Hadlow, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 15 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of The Anchor, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via High House Lane, Carpenters Lane, High Street, A26 Tonbridge Road, Ashes Lane and vice versa.

PIERCE MILL LANE, HADLOW (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Pierce Mill Lane, Hadlow, on or after 28th June 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30 or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Three Elm Lane and Hatch Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Court Lane, Victoria Road, Three Elm Lane and vice versa.

THE AVENUE, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of The Avenue, Tonbridge, on or after 14th July 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Lodge Road and Havelock Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Havelock Road, Lodge Road and vice versa.

THE HEATH, EAST MALLING (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow sewer connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of The Heath, East Malling, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 12 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of Hilltop Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via The Heath, Pikey Lane, Broadwater Road, Clare Lane, Mill Street, High Street, Chapel Street, Watlingtonbury Road and vice versa.

VARIOUS ROADS, IGHTHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow gas main replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on various roads in Ightham, on or after 4th July 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd September 2022, or until the works have been completed.

The works will be carried out in phases, as detailed below.

A227 Borough Green Road, Ightham

A227 Borough Green Road will be closed from 4th July 2022, with estimated completion by 26th August 2022.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Dark Hill Road and Fen Pond Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A227 Borough Green Road, A25 Sevenoaks Road, Maidstone Road, A20 London

Road, A228 Ashton Way, Malling Road, A26 Tonbridge Road, Maidstone Road, High Street, Tonbridge Road, Hadlow Road East, Cornwallis Avenue, Hadlow Road, A227 Borydyke, Shipbourne Road, Tonbridge Road, Bates Hill and The Street.

Rushmere Court, Ightham

Rushmere Court will be closed from 4th July 2022, with estimated completion by 29th July 2022.

The road will be closed at the junction with A227 Borough Green Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure, due to the road being a dead-end. However, residential access will be maintained at all times, when it is safe to do so.

Walker Place, Ightham

Walker Place will be closed from 4th July 2022, with estimated completion by 29th July 2022.

The road will be closed at the junction with A227 Borough Green Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure, due to the road being a dead-end. However, residential access will be maintained at all times, when it is safe to do so.

Fen Pond Road, Ightham

Fen Pond Road will be closed from 1st August 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd September 2022.

The road will be closed from the junction with A227 Borough Green Road to outside number 53, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A25 Sevenoaks Road, A227 Western Road, Wrotham Road, Borough Green Road and Kemsing Road.

The Close, Ightham

The Close will be closed from 1st August 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd September 2022.

The road will be closed at the junction with Fen Pond Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure, due to the road being a dead-end. However, residential access will be maintained at all times, when it is safe to do so.

TUNBRIDGE WELLS AREA

B2079 BEDGEBURY ROAD, GOUDHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2079 Bedgebury Road, Goudhurst, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 1 day between 08.00hrs and 18.00hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside New Pattenden Cottages.

The alternative route is via B2079 A21 London Road/Hastings Road/Lamberhurst By-Pass, A262 Goudhurst Road, Spelmonden Road/Station Road/Clayhill/West Road/High Street, B2079 Balcombes Hill and vice versa.

AMHURST BANK ROAD, PEMBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Amhurst Bank Road, Pembury, on or after 12th July 2022 for up to 3 days between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity Amhurst Hill Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Amhurst Bank Road, Half Moon Lane, Alders Road, A228 Colts Hill, A228 Maidstone Road, Redwings Lane, and vice versa.

BENTHAM HILL, ROYAL TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bentham Hill, Royal Tunbridge Wells, on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 1 day between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from its junction with Stockland Green Road, for a distance approximately 315 metres in a Northeast direction, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Bentham Hill, Victoria Road, Constitutional Hill Road, Kibbles Lane, Speldhurst Road, Stockland Green Road, and vice versa.

CALVERLEY STREET & GROVER STREET, TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Calverley Street, Royal Tunbridge Wells, on or after 3rd July 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed. The One-Way Order on Grover Street will be suspended to allow

the diversion route.

The road will be closed outside number 14.

The alternative route is via Garden Road, Camden Road, Grover Street and vice versa.

CULVERDEN STREET & A264 MOUNT EPHRAIM, TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Culverden Street and A264 Mount Ephraim, Tunbridge Wells, on or after 29th June 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

Culverden Street will be closed at the junction with A26 Mount Ephraim. A264 Mount Ephraim will be closed between A26 London Road and Royal Chase.

The alternative route for Culverden Street is via A26 Mount Ephraim, A263 Grosvenor Road and vice versa. The alternative route for A264 Mount Ephraim is via Castle Road, A264 Church Road, A26 London Road/ Mount Ephraim and vice versa.

DELMONDEN LANE, HAWKHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Delmonden Lane, Hawkhurst, on or after 29th June 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Delmonden Grange.

The alternative route is via Delmonden Lane, A268 High Street, A229 Highgate Hill/Moor Hill/The Moor/Horns Road and vice versa.

HENWOOD GREEN ROAD, PEMBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Henwood Green Road, Pembury, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 1 day between 08.00hrs and 18.00hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between numbers 81 and 85.

The alternative route is via Beagles wood Road, Lower Green Road, Romford Road, Henwood Green Road and vice versa.

HORDEN ROAD, CRANBROOK (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Horden Road, Cranbrook, on or after 11th July 2022 for up to 1 day between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed approximately 400 metres West from HM Prison, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Horden Road, Husheath Hill, Wilden Park Road, Curtisden Green Lane, and vice versa.

JARVIS LANE, GOUDHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Jarvis Lane, Goudhurst, on or after 27th June 2022 for up to 1 day between 08.00hrs and 18.00hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Combourne Lane and Latham Road.

The alternative route is via Jarvis Lane, Combourne Lane, Horden Road, Round Green Lane, Colliers Green Road, A262 Goudhurst Road/Cranbrook Road, B2084 Chequers Road and vice versa.

JARVIS LANE, GOUDHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Jarvis Lane, Goudhurst, on or after 28th June 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed

The road will be closed outside Lock and Key Cottage.

The alternative route is via Jarvis Lane, Latham Road, B2084 Chequers Road and vice versa.
