(VARIOUS ROADS, DARTFORD) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2020 (AMENDMENT NO.12) ORDER 2022

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Notice is given that The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter called "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

The effect of which would be the following:

- a. Introduce Disabled Badge Holders Only, maximum stay 3 hours no return within 1 hour, at the following location:
 - i. Broomfield Road, Swanscombe – from the common boundary of No.72 & 74, east for a distance of 6 metres.
 - ii. Church Road, Swanscombe – from the common boundary of No.40 & 42, east for a distance of 6 metres.
 - iii. Colney Road, New Town – from the common boundary of No.116 & 118 Colney Road, east for a distance of 6 metres.
 - iv. Henderson Drive, Temple Hill – from the common boundary of No.29 & 31 Henderson Drive, south for a distance of 6 metres.
 - v. Fulwich Road, New Town – from the common boundary of No.46 & 48 Fulwich Road, west for a distance of 6 metres.
- b. Revoke Disabled Badge Holders Only, maximum stay 3 hours no return within 1 hour, at the following location:
 - i. Colney Road, New Town – from the common boundary of No.78 & 80 west for distance of 6 metres.
 - ii. Lavinia Road, New Town – from the common boundary of No.24 & 26 Lavinia Road, east for a distance of 6 metres.
 - iii. The Brent, New Town, from the common boundary of No.105 & 107 The Brent, east for a distance of 6 metres.
- c. Introduce At any time waiting restrictions to the following locations:
 - i. Common Lane, Leyton Cross – southern kerb line, from a point 10 metres west of the junction of Broad Lane for a distance of 22 metres west
 - ii. Common Lane, Leyton Cross – Southern kerb line, from a point 29 metres west from the junction of Broad Lane for a distance of 24 metres west
 - iii. Devon Road, Sutton-at-Hone – southern kerb line, from a point 10 metres west of the western kerb line of the junction from Mill Stone Road to a point 10 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Mill Stone Road.
 - iv. Knockhall Road, Greenhithe – Both sides, from the junction of London Road, north for a distance of 20 metres.
 - v. London Road, Greenhithe – Southern kerb line, from a point 15 metres west of the western kerb line of the junction of Knockhall Road to a point 15 metres east of the eastern kerb line of the junction of Knockhall Road.
 - vi. Mill Stone Road, Sutton-at-Hone – Both sides from the junction of Devon Road for a distance of 10 metres south.
 - vii. Bow Arrow, Stone – eastern kerb line from a point 10 metres west from the junction of The Oaks to a point 20 metres east from the junction of The Oaks.
 - viii. The Oaks, Stone- Both sides, from the junction of Bow Arrow Lane, south for a distance of 10 metres.
 - ix. Bow Arrow Lane, Stone, western kerb line Osbourne Road for a distance of 10 metres west
 - x. Osbourne Road, Stone western kerb line, from the junction of Bow Arrow Lane for a distance of 10 metres south.
 - xi. Bow Arrow Lane, Stone eastern kerb line of Laurence Rise, east for a distance of 10 metres, to a point 10 metres west of the western kerb line.
 - xii. Laurence Rise, Stone, both sides from the junction of Bow Arrow Lane north for a distance of 10 metres.
 - xiii. Mitchell Close both sides from its junction with Warren Road for a distance of 10 metres north.
 - xiv. Warren Road from its junction with Mitchell Close for a distance of 10 metres west to a point 10 metres east of the junction of Mitchell Close.
- d. Introduce permit parking bays (Zone DE3) Mon-Fri 10am-2pm to the following locations:
 - i. Lavinia Road, New Town – from the common boundary of No.24 & 26 Lavinia Road, east for a distance of 6 metres.
- e. Introduce Waiting Restrictions Monday to Friday 7am to 10am in the following location:
 - i. Kent Road-Longfield, from the common boundary of No.17 & 19 Kent Road, west for a distance of 5 metres to a point 10 metres east.
- f. Restricted parking Zone, No waiting at any time
 - i. Extend the existing Restricted parking ZONE within Suffolk Road to cover the extent of Bulls Head Yard

The Order was made on 11 August 2022 and its provisions will come into effect on 12 August 2022.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.
